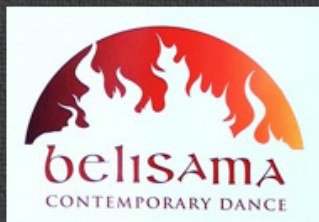

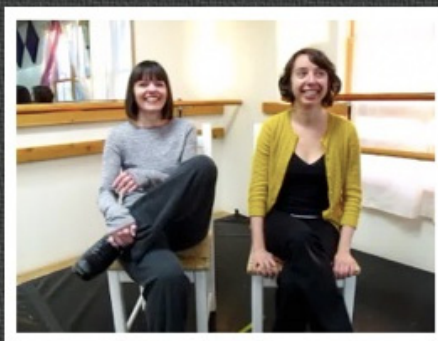
The school is located at 901 West San Mateo in Santa Fe, and consists of spacious dance studios complete with the expected floor to ceiling mirrors.

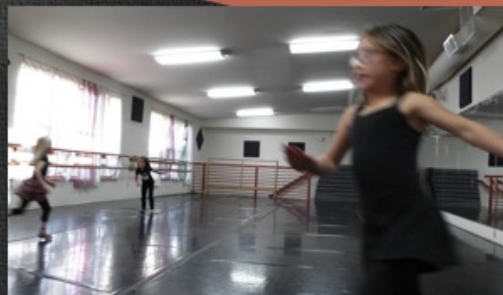
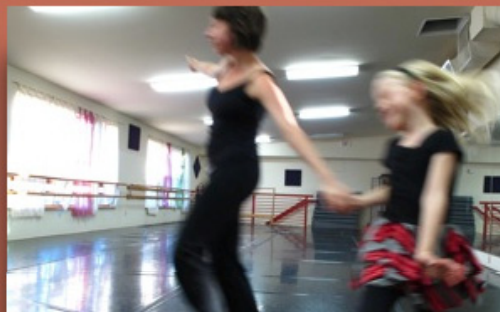
